Uncle Ethan's Frequently Asked Questions

What are Uncle Ethan's firelogs made of?

Uncle Ethan's firelogs are made of 100% recycled wood fiber.

How do they stay together without synthetic binders?

No additional wax or other artificial binders are ever used to make Uncle Ethan's firelogs. They are bonded with naturally occurring lignin in the wood fiber.

Do they smell like chemicals?

Uncle Ethan's firelogs only contain wood so they smell like burning firewood. They never create a chemical smell like other firelogs.

Can I use them for cooking?

Uncle Ethan's firelogs are as safe to cook over as any wood fire. As with any wood fire, it's recommended to let the flames burn down and cook over the hot coals.

Can I use Uncle Ethan's firelogs in my woodstove?

Yes. Uncle Ethan's firelogs are perfect for use in woodstoves, with benefits similar to wood pellets. They burn longer and hotter and more completely than cordwood, leaving less ash for you to clean up. They also create less creosote that can build up in your chimney.

Can I burn more than one firelog at once?

Yes. Unlike some other firelogs, we recommend burning more than one firelog at a time. Use Uncle Ethan's firelogs to build a fire similar to how you would build a fire with cordwood. However, our firelogs have a much higher BTU content than cordwood.

How do I light Uncle Ethan's firelogs?

For your convenience, we include a free firestarter in every package of Uncle Ethan's firelogs. Simply follow Uncle Ethan's tips for best results.

Why do they need to be stored in a dry place?

Because no artificial binders are used, the firelogs can be susceptible to moisture. When the firelogs get wet, the lignin is not able to hold the wood fiber together and the firelogs will expand and eventually turn to sawdust.

Why do I need to break off disks?

The disks allow more surface area to be exposed to the firestarter and will catch fire quicker than an entire firelog.

- 3-pack, 4 lb Firelogs (12 lb)
